



FOOT GOLF VOLUNTEER INSTRUCTIONS

LOCATION: Kino Sports Complex (south), 2500 E. Ajo Way, Tucson – (Field #7 in Quad Area)

ARRIVAL TIME: Friday night Olympics events begin at 7:15. Saturday night Olympics events begin at 6:30. Volunteers should arrive at their venues at least 30 minutes prior to start of the events. NOTE: the park is <u>VERY CONGESTED</u> on Friday night, Plan to arrive at the park well before 5:00pm if you plan to park near the Events Entrances. **Olympics Volunteers will check-in at Novelty Shop located between Gates A and B of the Stadium Field first**, then proceed to Foot Golf Check-in tent at extreme south end of Quad. FOOT GOLF VENUES: Friday night uses 6 courses for Foot Golf competition. Saturday night uses 3 courses for Foot Golf. These fields are located in the outfield along the baseline in the Baseball Quad area, Field #7, at Kino Sports Complex South.

BADGES: Before the event Volunteers are provided with badges used to assign each job. Wearing these badges will ensure volunteer assignments have been accomplished.

FOOT GOLF VOLUNTEER DUTIES: (volunteers needed – 23 vols Friday; 14 vols Saturday)

Check-In personnel (2-3 persons at Check-in Tent) Each Check-In person will monitor arrival of teams for their assigned field of competition and mark respective score sheets with those teams that have arrived to compete prior to the heat's scheduled start. Prior to start of each scheduled competition, you will hand score sheets for the next heat to Judge / Stroke Counter for each course. Start time for each heat is noted on each score sheet.

<u>Judge / Stroke Counter</u> (1 person for each goal) will be assigned to count the number of strokes each team uses to get the ball from the first pass to the kick that gets the ball into the goal. After each heat, hand completed score sheet to Foot Golf Assistant

<u>Foot-golf Assistant</u> (2 persons for each course) Assist Judge / Stroke Counter with managing score sheets and escorting winning players back to Check-In tent to receive 1st and 2nd place medals

<u>Awards (Medals Distribution)</u> (1-2 persons at Check-in Tent) Provide 1st and 2nd place medals to players upon completion of each competition. Distribution takes place at the same tent location where teams check-in for their event. Foot Golf Assistants will direct winning teams to the Check-In tent and Awards persons will assist in ensuring players receive their medals.

NOTE: Team Late Arrivals - Because all Soccer Olympics events are running simultaneously, late arrivals to any heat cannot be rescheduled regardless of the schedules of the other events.













Foot Golf Event Competition Format & Player's Instructions

- 1. Foot Golf events take place at Kino Sports Park South Field #7 of the Quad. See area map at entrance to fields or entrance to Quad for location of Foot Golf Events.
- 2. There are 6 different Foot Golf courses on Friday night (3 on Saturday night). Make sure you know which course and what time your event takes place before you arrive at the park.
- 3. Each team opposes all other teams in their bracket.
- 4. The course consists of a starting line, 3 wickets and a small-sided goal.
- 5. Each team will provide four players, 1 player at the START, 3 remaining players each behind each wicket. Player 1 starts the course with a pass through wicket to the next player. Each subsequent player receives pass (through the wicket) and passes the ball to the next player through the next wicket. The 4th player receives the ball through her wicket and then shoots on the goal.
- 6. Each kick by players advancing the ball counts as a stroke. If the ball fails to pass through the wicket, receiving player returns ball to passing player and team incurs a penalty stroke. Stroke counters will determine how many strokes were taken from player 1's first pass to the ball entering the goal. A missed shot on goal incurs one penalty stroke and play is ended. Team with least number of strokes in head-to-head competition advances to next bracket.
- 5. Tournament will provide size 3 balls for all Foot-Golf events.
- 6. Judges / Stroke Counters or Assistants will clearly mark 1st and 2nd place teams and stroke count on score sheet.
- 7. 1st and 2nd place winners, determined by lowest stroke count, will follow Foot Golf Assistant back to the Foot Golf Check-in entrance tent to receive their award medals.
- 8. Players should be at the event 15 MINUTES prior to the scheduled time of heat.
- 9. Because all Soccer Olympics events are running simultaneously, late arrivals to any heat cannot be rescheduled regardless of the schedules of the other events.
